Ethical failures can be caused by different types of problems. Some of these problems are caused by individuals and others may be instilled in local government values.

Government ethics relates to the processes, behavior, and policy of governments and their employees. The function of local government and its officials is to serve the public interest with ethical awareness and ethical actions. When governments serve the public interest and avoid engaging in conduct that promotes any private interests, they are acting for the good of their taxpayers.

Government ethics refers to a particular professional code of conduct for those who work in and for government. Government ethics involves rules and guidelines about right and wrong conduct.
