We are often sharing insights about the importance of ethics policies in various government entities. Faux pas is most commonly used to talk about an embarrassing mistake made in a situation. Therefore, saying some made a faux pas is equivalent to saying they made a blunder. Interestingly, the meaning of the phrase isn't far removed from its original meaning, "to compromise one's reputation." Faux pas is a remark or action in a social situation that is a mistake and causes embarrassment or offense

This webinar will explore the "newer" interpretation of ethics in government, including "when is a gratuity a bribe (or not)." It will look at recent cases, ethical dilemmas, and the faux pas of government employees and officials.


