Congress has introduced comprehensive ethics reform legislation aimed at closing regulatory loopholes, restoring institutional trust, and expanding accountability. These legislative efforts directly cover insider trading, artificial intelligence (AI), gifts, reimbursements, and purchasing.

Recent legislation marks a significant shift from simple financial disclosure to outright prohibition.

- **The Stop Insider Trading Act (H.R. 7008):** Passed by the House of Representatives, this bill explicitly bans Members of Congress, their spouses, and dependent children from purchasing individual stocks in publicly traded companies.
- **Advance Sale Notification:** Lawmakers must file a public notice with the Clerk of the House or Secretary of the Senate between 7 and 14 days before any intended stock sale.

This webinar will take a Birds Eye look at ethics foibles, transgressions, and case law in 2026. It will include looks at recent legislation and proposed legislation in areas such as insider trading, artificial intelligence, gifts, reimbursements and purchasing.
