Clean water and proper sanitation are more than just vital resources. They are dominant forces for modification, creating the basis of public health, economic growth, and green sustainability.

Insignificant water quality and inadequate sanitation adversely impact food security, incomes, and educational opportunities for disadvantaged families around the world, especially for women and children who spend endless hours getting water over long distances.

If the food supply chain were a formula, local government regulations would be the extremely detailed, constantly updated, and sometimes conflicting instructions. Food safety standards command everything from farm cleanliness to processing temperatures and transportation conditions. Classifying laws determine what information must appear on a package. Environmental procedures influence farming practices and waste disposal.

This webinar will give a brief review on how Government purchasing plays a vital role in preserving food supplies, clean water and the general health and welfare of its consumers.
