How do we apply “Green Procurement” with recent changes in Government philosophies, climate issues, energy needs, PFAS, and contaminants.

Economic and environmental concerns have contributed to rising interest in green procurement—a term used in various ways but that may best be described as acquisition of products and services with smaller-than-average environmental footprints. Fully assessing a product or service requires integrated evaluation of cost, performance, and impacts for a set of green factors over all stages of the life cycle.

Governments have a particularly central and extensive role to play that goes far beyond the provision of funds for green technology. Green technology is the use of technology for environmental purposes, like for example reducing energy consumption, reducing waste, and protecting the environment.
