Local governments have large expenditures and controlling powers, which gives dishonest officials many ways to provide illegal benefits. Local officials have authority over licensing, permitting, zoning, contracting, granting, tax breaks, and other kinds of approvals and payments. The larger the government, the larger the corruption chances.

In local governments across New Jersey, ethical conduct and transparency are foundations of public trust and effective authority. Municipal officials are assigned with managing public resources and making decisions that affect the lives of their constituents. To maintain this responsibility, they must follow strict ethical standards and ensure that their operations are visible to the public.

The Local Government Ethics Law summaries specific ethical standards that municipal officials must follow. This includes procedures for financial disclosure, preventions against accepting gifts from vendors, and rules for conflicts of interest. Officials must file annual Financial Disclosure Statements to ensure clarity regarding their personal financial interests.

This webinar will review of classic ethics cases, stings and failures in government ethics and how to approach ethics in an always changing government structure.
